

A catalog of the types of *Chrysomelidae sensu lato* (Insecta, Coleoptera, Polyphaga) deposited in the Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales, Buenos Aires

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Abstract: The type specimens (all current categories) of *Chrysomelidae s.l.* deposited in this Museum are listed; 125 names are recorded, 85 of them (68 percent) are represented here by name-bearing types ('primary' types), five of them dubious. The family is taken in its broadest sense, including the Bruchinae, Hispinae (along with the former Cassidinae), and other groups sometimes considered as separate families. The specific and subspecific names were alphabetically filed, followed by the generic ones as they were spelled in the original publication, or the generic and specific names in the case of subspecies and varieties. Later combinations and/or current *binomina* are mentioned insofar as these are known to the authors. Two lists are added: 1. of specimens labelled as types of unavailable names, chiefly those not found in the literature, and supposedly not published, and 2. of specimens labelled as types, but not originally included as such, and published or not after the original description.

Key words: Chrysomelidae, Coleoptera, type specimens, Argentina.

Resumen: Catálogo de los tipos de *Chrysomelidae sensu lato* (Insecta, Coleoptera, Polyphaga) depositados en el Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales, Buenos Aires. Se catalogan los ejemplares típicos, de todas las categorías aceptadas, de *Chrysomelidae s.l.* conservados en este museo; se registran 125 nombres, 85 de ellos (68 por ciento) representados aquí por tipos portadores de nombres (tipos 'primarios'), cinco de ellos dudosos. La familia se toma en su concepto más amplio, incluyendo a las Bruchinae, las Hispinae (con las anteriores Cassidinae) y otros grupos a veces considerados como familias separadas. Los nombres específicos y subespecíficos fueron ordenados alfabéticamente; a estos siguen los de los géneros, así como se publicaron originalmente, o de los géneros y especies en el caso de las subespecies y variedades. Se mencionan las combinaciones ulteriores y/o los binomios en uso, hasta donde son conocidos por los autores. Se agregan dos listas: 1. de los ejemplares rotulados como tipos, de nombres no disponibles, principalmente aquellos no hallados en la bibliografía, y supuestamente no publicados, y 2. de los ejemplares rotulados como tipos, pero no incluidos originalmente como tales, publicados o no después de la descripción original.

Palabras clave: Chrysomelidae, ejemplares tipo, Argentina.

A catalog of the typical specimens (all current categories) of species of *Chrysomelidae s.l.* housed in the Entomological Division of this Museum is presented, referred to 125 names: 25 holotypes (four of them dubious, they may be syntypes), 95 syntypes (six of them dubious) of 55 names, 179 paratypes (which include 6 allotypes). Of these 125 names, 85 of them (68 percent) are here represented by name-bearing types ('primary types'). The family is here taken in its broadest sense, including the Bruchinae, the Hispinae (with the former Cassidinae) and other groups sometimes considered as separate families. The classification of Lawrence & Newton (1995) is here followed.

Specific and subspecific names are alphabetically entered, as is usual in type specimen catalogs; each name is followed by the generic one, and the subgeneric one if it was mentioned, spelled as it was in the original binomen, or by the generic and

specific ones in the case of subspecies and varieties. An abbreviated bibliographic citation follows, as well as a listing of the types, if these were mentioned, starting with those deposited in this Museum. An account of the type specimens actually here housed follows, with their label data. According to the International Code of Zoological Nomenclature (4th edition, 1999), allotypes are not 'name-bearing types'. If the country is not mentioned, Argentina is meant; in every other case, the country is mentioned first. Some specimens bear a registration number, entered in the Entomology Division register; numbers under 10000 correspond to the old general register of the Museum. Later nomenclatural or taxonomical changes are added, insofar as these are known to the authors.

For the identification of types not formally designated in the original publication (art. 72.4 of the Code), evidences from the labels as they were writ-

ten in the collections examined by authors of names, are considered. When the authors did not formally designate a holotype, or its equivalent, and did not mention how many specimens were examined, it is assumed that they had a series of syntypes (recommendation 73 F of the Code), eventually 'sole syntypes'.

Some specimens in the collection are labelled as types of names not found in the literature, and assumed not to have been published. These names are probably not available in the sense of the Code; however, in order to assist in future research, they are separately listed.

Specimens labelled as types, but not included in the original publication, and specimens designated as types after the original publication date, published or not, cannot be accepted as included in the type series; however, also in order to assist in future research, they are included in a third list.

Burmeister did not label his types nor other specimens, save sometimes with locality labels; he put, to the left of the specimens or series, a handwritten identification label, fastened with pins to the bottom of the drawer; and added sometimes a vague distribution indication, e.g. «Patagonia» or even «Argentina». The type condition is inferred from the publications, and one of us (AOB) added labels, handwritten on red cardboard, to the specimens deemed to be holotypes or syntypes.

Brèthes often marked his type specimens with a small square piece of red paper, making their identification in the drawers easier.

Bruch used to copy the specific names of the types on his own labels, most of them with a red frame (a few with a green frame), and to add to the same pin a small, folded piece of paper with the name handwritten by the respective author, seemingly cut from a letter; frequently only a part of the generic name, and/or a part of the author's name are legible.

Some specimens in the Bruch collection are labelled as 'cotypes'. If the author did not state how many specimens he had examined, they must be considered as syntypes. We suspect that some of the 'cotypes' in our Museum were not even included in the typical series, but it is not possible to assure their condition. In order to assist in future research, we include them in the present paper as syntypes or as paratypes, according to each context (Bruch used the term '*Cotypus*' sometimes in the sense of *syntypus* and sometimes in the sense of *paratypus*). Lastly, one name (*Probaenia crenata* ab. *interrupta* Monrós & Viana 1947: 273, pl. xxii: 91) although not an available name, is included within this list because of the same reason.

No type specimens were found of 1. *Magalostomis (Scaphigenia) bubalus bubaloides*

Monrós (1954: 99-102), of which some paratypes are said to be in **MACN**, **BRC** and **GPC**; 2. *Uroplata oglobini [sic]* Monrós & Viana (1947: 288-289), of which some 'cotypes' are said to be in **MACN**; 3. *Stereoma laevicollis orophila* Monrós (1954: 224-225), of which some paratypes are said to be in **MACN** and **BRC**; 4. *Megalopus schaeferi* Monrós (1947c: 211-212), of which one paratypes is said to be in **MACN ex ABC**.

Unless otherwise stated, the specimens are glued to cards held by an entomological pin.

achalay [*Chlamisus*]. Monrós 1952b: 592-594, f. 87, 136. La Rioja Prov.: Nonogasta, leg. M. Gómez, one **parat.** ex **BRC**. **Holot.** male, Salta Prov.: Coronel Moldes in **MC**, one **parat.** in **USNM**.

One **parat.** «Nonogasta / Rioja / Gómez» handwr. by Bruch; «Col. / C. Bruch» print. with red ink; «53380» handwr., red frame; «Paratypus» print. on yellow cardboard; «Chlamisus / achalay / mihi [handwr.] / F. Monrós det. 1949 [print.]» on pink paper. Ex **BRC**.

acuminatus [*Cryptocephalus*]. Jacoby 1908: 838. Tucumán; in addition one spec. in **MLP**.

One **synt.** «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Tucumán / 15.VII.1900 / C. Bruch» print., date handwr.; «Cotypus» print. on pale green paper; «Cryptocephalus / acuminatus / Jac.» handwr. by Bruch, red frame. Ex **BRC**.

acutangula [*Hybosa*]. Spaeth 1913: 163-164. Abundant in Paraguay; Brasil: Espiritu Santo, and Argentina: Misiones leg. Jörgensen.

One **synt.**, pinned, «Rep. Argentina / Gob. Misiones / XI.1909 / C. Bruch» print., date handwr. «Cotypus» print. on pale green paper; «Hybosa / acutangula / Spth.» handwr. by Bruch, red frame; «Hybosa / acutangula» handwr., cut. Ex **BRC**.

albopilosa [*Euryscopa*]. Monrós 1954: 106-109, f. 146-154. Santiago del Estero Prov., 3 **parat.** ex **BRC**. **Holot.** ♂, allot. ♀, several **parat.** Misiones Prov.: San Javier: Santa María, in **MC**; other parat. in **BM**, **DEI**, **MLP**, **FIML**, **MVC**, **JBC**, **AMC**.

Three **parat.**, two of them «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Santiago d. Estero / 190_ / C. Bruch» print., black frame; the other one «Sgo. Estero» handwr.; «Paratipo» handwr. on white paper, with a red frame; «Euryscopa / albopilosa / mihi [handwr.] / F. Monrós det. 1950 [print.]» on pink paper, ex **BRC**. two parat. «Argentina / Buenos Aires / Pdo. de Puan / Est. Felipe Solá / Coll. Martínez / Dic. 951 [952]» handwr. on white paper; «Euryscopa / albopilosa / Monrós / Paratipo» handwr. with pencil. Ex **AMC**.

Note: Moldenke (1981: 92) described the new genus *Coleorozena*, assigning *Euryscopa albopilosa* to it.

alvarengai [*Megamerus*]. Monrós 1956: 108-111, 113, f. 1-13. Brasil: Rio Grande do Norte: Natal,

leg. Alvarenga 25.IV.1950, **holot.** ♂, **allot.** ♀. in **DZSP**; 3 **parat.** **MAC**, 1 **parat.** **CSC**, 1 **parat.** **MC**.

One **parat.**, pinned, a leg glued to a pointed card, «Coleção / M. Alvarenga / N 1503» printed; «Natal / R.G. Norte Brasil / 25-IV-1950 / M. Alvarenga Coll.» print., date handwr.; «Paratipo» handwr. on white paper with a red frame; «Megamerus / alvarengai / Monrós [handwr.] / F. Monrós det. 1955 [print.]» on pink paper with a black frame.

anthracinus [*Monachus*]. Burmeister 1877: 62-63. Patagonia, Río Negro Prov. (*sic, pro* Buenos Aires Prov.): Carmen de Patagones.

One **synt.** without labels. On the bottom of the drawer a label reads «anthracinus Nob.». One of us (AOB) added «Monachus / anthracinus / Burmeister 1877 / Typus» handwr. on red cardboard. Ex **HB**.

Note: Blackwelder (1946: 643) records this species under *Lexiphanes* Gistel 1850 *nom. nov. pro Monachus* Déjean 1835, *non* Kaup 1829 *nec* Fleming 1822. Leng (1918: 208) proposed *Monachulus* as a replacement name.

argentina [*sub Argentina*] [*Coscinoptera*]. Burmeister 1877: 60-61. [Entre Ríos Prov.]: Paraná, and southern Corrientes Prov.

Two **synt.**, pinned, one of them «Parana / Febr.» print. on dark green paper, the other without labels. One of us (AOB) added to both «Coscinoptera / argentina / Burmeister 1877 / Syntypus» handwr. on red cardboard. Ex **HB**.

Note: Moldenke (1981: 96) proposed the new subgenus *Coleoguerina*, assigning *Coscinoptera argentina* as the type species.

argentinensis [*Chaetocnema*]. Bryant 1951: 941-942, f. 4. Argent.: Est. Exp. Station XI.1948, 23 spec.; [Entre Ríos Prov.]: Nogoyá XI.1948, leg. Hepper.

Eight **synt.?** **parat.?** on four cards on one pin; three paper disks, «Paratype», with yellow border; «Victoria E.R.-XI.48 / H.C. Hepper», «Maíz dulce-amargo / sorgo azucarado» handwr. by Hepper; «Com. Inst. Ent. / Coll. n°. [print.] 12021 [handwr.]»; «53249» handwr., red frame; «Chaetocnema / argentinensis / Bryant [handwr.] / G.E. Bryant det. [print.]» on white paper.

Note: No types were formally designated, so a series of synt. should be assumed, but the specimens are labelled «Paratypus», rendering the category doubtful.

argentinensis [*Mastotethus*]. Jacoby 1904a: 65-66. Tucumán, two spec.

Two **synt.**, pinned «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Tucumán / XII.1897 / C. Bruch» print., date handwr.; «Typus» print. on pale green paper;

«*Mastostethus / argentinensis / Jac. / Co-tipo*» handwr. by Bruch, red frame. *Ex BRC*.

argentinensis [*Metallactus*]. Jacoby 1908: 850-851. Córdoba. Seemingly a single spec., as only one measure was given.

Holot?, **synt.?** «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Córdoba / 190_ / C. Bruch» print.; «Cotypus» print. on pale green paper; «*Metallactus / argentinensis / Jac.*» handwr. by Bruch, red frame. *Ex BRC*.

Note: The 'Cotypus' label suggests that Jacoby examined more than one spec.

argentinus [*Cryptocephalus*]. Jacoby 1908: 844. Buenos Aires, received from **MLP**.

One **synt.**, «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Buenos Aires / 27.XI.1904 / C. Bruch» print., date handwr.; «Cotypus» print. on pale green paper; «*Cryptocephalus / argentinus / Jac.*» handwr. by Bruch, red frame. *Ex BRC*.

atra [*Octhispa*]. Weise 1922: 32. Prov. Buenos Aires, *ex BRC*.

Holot. «Typus» print. on pale green paper; «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Buenos Aires / 190_ / C. Bruch» print.; «Dibujado» [drawn] handwr.; «51056» handwr, red frame; «*Octhispa / atra / Ws.*» handwr. by Bruch, red frame; «*Octhis / atra*» handwr., cut; «*Nanocthispa / atra* (Weise) / Det. M. Viana [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print.] [obverse] / X-1947 [handwr.] [reverse]» on white cardboard. *Ex BRC*.

Note: Recorded as *Nanocthispa atra* by Monrós & Viana (1947: 313, pl. xxvi: 116), who state to have examined the type.

atricornis [*Probaenia*]. Pic 1927: 9. Argentina, in **BRC** and **PC**.

Two **synt.** on cards, on one pin, «Typus» handwr. on pale green paper; «Alta Gracia. La Granja / Sierras de Córdoba / 16.II.927. C. Bruch leg.» print., date handwr.; «51026» handwr., red frame; «Col. / C. Bruch» print.; «*Probaenia / atricornis / Pic*» handwr. by Bruch, red frame; «*Probaenia / atricornis*» handwr., cut; «*Uroplata / (Cardiohispa) / jucunda / Chap. / Det. M. Viana [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print.] [obverse] / X-1947 [handwr.] [reverse]*» on white cardboard. *Ex BRC*.

Notes: Transferred to *Uroplata* by Uhmman (1937a: 457). A synonym of *Uroplata (Cardiohispa) jucunda* Chapuis 1877, after Monrós & Viana (1947: 295-296, pl. xxv: 107). Descarpentries & Villiers (1959: 150) state that they examined the 'holotype' in the Pic collection, and that it comes from Córdoba Prov.

basalis [*Araeostenus*]. Brèthes 1922: 286-287. [Paraná River Delta]: Islas del Tigre 26.II.1911.

Holot., «Tuyuparé / 26.II.11 / J.B.» handwr. by Brèthes, black frame; «*Araeostenus / basalis / Brèthes*», «type!» handwr. by Brèthes; a small square piece of red paper. One of us (AOB) added «Holotypus» printed on red cardboard. *Ex JBR*.

bicoloriceps [*Anisostena*]. Pic 1928a: 51-52. Corrientes Prov.: San Roque, *leg. Bosq*, in **BRC** and **JBC**.

One **synt.** «Corrientes / I.1921. De Carlo» handwr. by Bruch; «Col. / C. Bruch» print.; «50940» handwr., red frame; «Typus» print. on red cardboard; «*Anisostena / bicoloriceps / Pic*» handwr. by Bruch, red frame; «*Anisostena / bicoloriceps*» handwr., cut; «*Anisostena / (Neostena) / bicoloriceps / Pic / Det. M. Viana [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print.] [obverse] / X-1947 [handwr.] [reverse]*» on white cardboard. *Ex BRC*.

Notes: The collector's name differs, but otherwise the labels seem authentic. Included in subgenus *Anisostena (Neostena)* by Monrós & Viana (1947: 204-206), who consider *Charistena elongaticeps* Pic 1928 as a synonym. Descarpentries & Villiers (1959) state no type is in **PC**.

bisignata [*Mecistomela (Coraliomela) vicina* var.]. Berg 1900: 256. Bolivia, in **MACN**.

Holot., pinned «Bolivia / S. Mart.» handwr. on green paper, reverse white; «Col. / Antigua» print. on pale yellowish paper; «51105» handwr., red frame; «Typus» print. on red paper; «var. *bisignata* Berg», «*vicina* (Guér.)», handwr. by Berg on yellowish paper.

Notes: Currently included in *Coraliomela*. This variety was not dealt with by Monrós & Viana (1947).

bivitticollis [*Cryptocephalus*]. Jacoby 1908: 838-839. Argentina, perhaps a single spec., as only one measure is given.

Holot?, **synt.?** «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Buenos Aires / I.1895 / C. Bruch» printed, date handwr.; «Cotypus» print. on pale green paper; «*Cryptocephalus / bivitticollis / Jac.*» handwr. by Bruch, red frame. *Ex BRC*.

Note: The 'Cotypus' label suggests that Jacoby could have seen more than one spec.

brittocostai [*Chlamisus*]. Bokermann 1962a: 277. 3 ♀ (1018-1020), 1 ♂ (1021), without other data.

Three **parat.** «Colecção Bokermann», print. on red paper; «George Oeterer / São Paulo - Brasil / 23-X-1961 / Werner col.», print., date handwr.; «*Chlamisus / brittocostai / Paratipo* ♀ [on two], [♂

on the other] [handwr.] / Bokermann det. 1962 [print.]» on red paper; «1019» [«1020», «1021»], typed, the last one *ex* **AMC**.

brochoni [*Plectonycha*]. Brèthes 1925: 15-16. Santa Fe, Brochon *leg*.

Holot. «S^{ta} Fe / L. Brochon» handwr.; «Rep. Argentina / M. Viana / I-1960» handwr.; «2531» handwr.; «Plectonycha / Brochoni / Brèthes» handwr. by Brèthes. One of us (AOB) added «Typus» printed on pink cardboard. *Ex* **JBR**.

Note: Monrós (1947b: 47, 53, 62-63, f. 9) states having examined the holot. and several parat. from the same locality, from **JBR**.

bruchii [*Cephalodonta*]. Weise 1904: 443. Buenos Aires Prov. 10.V.1897, several spec. *ex* **BRC**.

One **synt.** «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Buenos Aires / 10.V.1897 / C. Bruch» print., date handwr.; «Col. / C. Bruch» print.; «50927» handwr., red frame; «Typus» print. on red paper; «Cephalodonta / Bruchi / Weise - tipo» handwr. by Bruch, red frame; «Cephalodonta / Bruchi m.» handwr., cut; «Sceloenopla / (Pseudispa) [sic] / bruchi Weise / Det. M. Viana [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print.] [obverse] / X-1947 [handwr.] [reverse]» on white cardboard with a black frame. *Ex* **BRC**.

Note: Monrós & Viana (1947: 189-190, pl. iii: 13) examined the «type series» in **MACN**, and transferred the species to *Sceloenopla* (*Pseudispa*) [sic, *pro Pseudhispa*]. They put another spec. in **BRC**, taken after the publication date, and not labelled as a type.

bruchii [*Stethispa*]. Weise 1906: 224. Misiones Prov. V.1895.

Holot. «Rep. Argentina / Gob. Misiones / 5.1895 / C. Bruch» print., date handwr.; «Col. / C. Bruch» print. «Typus» print. on red paper; «Stethispa / Bruchi / Weise. tipo» handwr. by Bruch, red frame; «Stethispa / Bruchi m.» handwr., cut; «Stethispa / bruchi Weise / Det. M. Viana [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print.] [obverse] / X-1947 [handwr.] [reverse]». *Ex* **BRC**.

bruchii [*Rhinotmetus*]. Bowditch 1915: 490. Buenos Aires Prov., several spec. *ex* **BRC**; *ex* 2^d coll. Jacoby *sub* 28c.

One **synt.** «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Buenos Aires / IV.1896 [?] / C. Bruch» print., date handwr.; «Typus» print. on pale green paper; «Rhinotmetus / Bruchii / Bowd.» handwr. by Bruch, red frame; «Rhinotmetus / Bruchii / nov. spec. Bow.» handwr., cut. *Ex* **BRC**.

carbonarius [*Cryptocephalus*]. Burmeister 1877: 64-65. Buenos Aires.

Two **synt.**, one of them «Buen / Ayres» print. on green paper, the other without labels. One of us (AOB) added to both «*Cryptocephalus / carbonarius / Burmeister 1877 / Syntypus*» handwr. on red cardboard. *Ex* **HB**.

Two **synt?**, **parat. ?** glued to cards, on one pin, three circular «Paratype» labels with yellow border; «Rio 4° / s/papa 1940» handwr.; «Com. Inst. Ent. / Coll. N°. 12021» print., number handwr.; «53426» handwr., red frame; «Epitrix / hepperi / Bryant [handwr.] / G.E. Bryant det. [print.]» on white paper.

immersa [*Cassida*]. Spaeth 1909: 389-390. [Santa Fe Prov.?]: Rosario; Brasil; Buenos Aires, coll. Clavareau; Buenos Aires *ex* **BRC** (MLP); [Uruguay]: Montevideo *ex* **MCSN**.

One **synt.** «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Buenos Aires / 4.XII.1895 / C. Bruch» print., date handwr.; «Typus» print. on pale green paper; «Cassida / immersa / Spth.» handwr. by Bruch, red frame; «Cassida / immersa typ! [handwr.] / Spaeth det. [print.]» cut. *Ex* **BRC**.

inaurata [*Mesomphalia*]. Burmeister 1870: 275-276. Tucumán, «Männchen» [male].

Two **synt.** «Tucuman» print. on green paper. On the bottom of the drawer a label reads «*inaurata* Nob. / Rep. Arg. Br.» handwr. by Burmeister; «Col. Antigua» print.. *Ex* **HB**.

Notes: Recorded as *Pseudomesomphalia inaurata* by Spaeth (1914: 38). Barber & Bridwell (1940: 9) considered *Pseudomesomphalia* as a synonym of *Stolas*. There are two further spec. labelled «4174» [handwr.] and «Tucuman» [print. on green paper]. In the old general register of the Museum, the entry 4174 corresponds to a large ensemble of insects collected in Tucumán by Dinelli, entered in 1898.

Bruch» print., date handwr.; «51018» handwr., red frame, not mentioned in the original description. It is not clear if it was intended to conform the type series (see at the third list below). Monrós & Viana (1947: 272-273, pl. xxii: 90) synonymized *P. infirmior* with *P. crenata* ab. *nigripes* (Chapuis 1877), an unavailable name, as it was proposed for an *aberratio*.

Note: Hincks (1950: 509) considers *Chelymormpha* as a synonym of *Cyphomormpha* Chevrolat.

Note: The name was described as a variety before 1960, and is therefore available.

jacobyi [*sub Jacobyi*] [*Megalopus*]. Bruch 1908: 716-717, 1 f. Salta, 1 spec.; Tucumán Prov.: Taff III.1908; Richter obtained several spec.

Two (three?) **synt.**, pinned. One of them «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Salta / 190_ / C. Bruch» print.;

«Typus» printed on pale green paper; «Megalopus / Jacobyi / m. tipo [handwr. by Bruch] / C. Bruch determ. [print.]». The other two «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Tucumán / 5.II.1908 [on one, the other III.1908] / C. laetificus [*Chalepus*]. Weise 1906: 224. Formosa II.1895.

One **synt.** «Typus» print. on pale green paper; «Rep. Argentina / Gob. Formosa / 2.1895 / C. Bruch» print., date handwr.; «Col. / C. Note: Moldenke (1981: 111) erected the new genus *Paraurodera* and mentioned that it is doubtful to place *Urodera lanuginosa* in it.]

Notes: Recorded as *Himantidium limbatum* by Monrós & Viana (1947: 160-161, pl. v: 21) who examined the type series, and as *Cephaloleia limbata* by Descarpentries & Villiers (1959: 139) who report one parat. in **PC**. The type locality corresponds to the Paraná River Delta, in Buenos Aires Prov. *Cephaloleia* is the correct spelling.

maculata [*Uhmannispa*]. Monrós & Viana 1947: 172-174, pl. vi: 24. Chaco Prov.: Fontana 5.III.1935 leg. Meyer, **holot.** in **MACN**. Chaco Prov., 1 **parat.** in **MLP**; Chaco Prov.: Puerto Tirol, leg. Daguerre 1 **parat.**

Note: Under the heading «Chlamisus melochiae» there are in the drawer two specimens from Concordia, Entre Ríos Province, Argentina. Both are rotulated «Paratypus», and one of them is rotulated also «Chlamisus sphaeralceae». At the Instituto Lillo, Tucumán, where the other types are housed, the specimens are also rotulated «sphaeralceae», not «melochiae». In the rather extensive paper of Monrós, *Chlamisus melochiae* is the only species collected on *Sphaeralcea* sp. (Malvaceae) and on *Melochia* sp. (Sterculiaceae), no other species come from any of these plants. Probably Monrós wished to name the species after a nourishing plant, selecting at first instance *sphaeralceae*, and shifted later to *melochiae*, but he failed to replace the labels from the specimens. Therefore I decided to hold the specimens as authentic, and we add to them an additional label reading «Chlamisus melochiae Monrós 1952. Acta zoologica lilloana 10: 600-602» print. on white paper.

Notes: Staines (1993: 187-188) refers this species to his new subgenus *Anisostena* (*Apostena*). Two syntypes are deposited in the USNM.

Note: Recorded as *Oediopalpa negligens* by Blackwelder (1946: 717).

neivai [*Himatidium*]. Bondar 1940a: 205-209, f. 1-3. Brasil: Bahia: Agua Preta, **holot.** in **BC**, 19 **parat.** in **IIE**, **ERJ**.

Martínez» handwr.; «Cotype» print. on dark red paper with a black frame; «Himatidium / neivai / Bondar» handwr. on white paper, black frame; «Imatidium / Neivai / Det. Bondar» handwr. on white paper, remainings of a black frame.

Notes: The correct spelling is *Imatidium*. Borowiec (1999: 185) refers this species to the genus *Demotispa*.

nigropicta [*Epitrix*]. Bryant 1951: 938-939, f. 1. [Buenos Aires Prov.]: Balcarce *leg.* Hepper II.1948, 3 spec. on potato plants.

One **synt.?** **parat.?**, «Paratype» printed on a yellow-margined disk; «ex planta de papa», «Balcarce II-1948 / H.C. Hepper», both handwr. by Hepper; «Com. Inst. Ent. Coll. no. 12021» printed, number handwr.; «53427» handwr., red frame; «Epitrix / nigropicta / Bryant [handwr.] / G.E. Bryant det. [print.]» on white paper.

Note: The spec. are rotulated as paratypes, but they could be syntypes.

nigrovittis [*Metallactus*]. Jacoby 1908: 855. Argentina: Chaco [perhaps a single spec., as only one measurement is given].

Holot.? **synt.?**, not even a type? «Rep. Argentina / Gob. Chaco / 190_ / C. Bruch» printed; «Cotypus» printed on pale green paper; «*Metallactus / nigrovittis / Jac.*» handwr. by Bruch, red frame. *Ex* **BRC**.

Note: The type condition is dubious, as the only identification label is handwr. by Bruch, not by Jacoby.

notaticeps [*Brachycoryna*]. Pic 1928c: 4.

pallipes [*Decatelia*]. Weise 1922: 31. Paraguay: Santa Trinidad X.1913 leg. Zürcher.

One **parat.** «S. Tomé / Corrientes / 10-927» print., date handwr., black frame; «Paratipo» handwr., red frame; «*D. complexa / ssp. pallipes / mihi* [handwr.] / F. Monrós det. 1951 [print.]» on pink paper. *Ex* **GPC**.

parallela [*Stenispa*]. Pic 1930: 45. Buenos Aires Prov.: Rosas, leg. Daguerre, in **BRC** and **PC**. Types not formally designated.

Three **synt.** on cards, on 2 pins «Rosas - F.C.Sud / Provincia de Buenos Aires / Juan B. Daguerre» print.; «Col. / C. Bruch» print.; «50914» on the pin with 1, «50915» on the pin with 2, handwr., red frame; «Typus» print. on red paper on the pin with 1; handwr. by Bruch on pale green paper on the pin with 2; «*Stenispa / parallela / Pic*» handwr. by Bruch; «*Stenispa / parallela n.sp.*» handwr., cut; «*Stenispa / parallela / Pic / Det. Notes: Descarpentries & Villiers (1959) state that the holotype is housed in the Muséum National d'Histoire Naturelle in Paris. Three specimens labelled as paratypes are deposited in the USNM. Note: Synonymized with *Lema orbigny* (Guérin 1844) by Monrós (1947a: 169) along with *L. dorsalis* Frers 1922.

polichroma [*Lema*]. Monrós 1952a: 33-42, f. 1, 3-25. Salta, 2 **spec.** *ex* **HB**; Tucumán, 3 **spec.** *ex* **BRC**;

Tucumán Prov.: Tafí 1 **spec. ex BRC**; Santiago del Estero, 7 **spec. ex BRC**. Other **spec. MLP, FIML, MC, JBC**. Types not formally designated.

Twelve **synt.**, 3 of them «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Tucumán / 3.1.1908 [9.11.1908] / C. Bruch» print., dates handwr. 1 of them «Valle Tafí / Tucumán» handwr. by Bruch. 7 of them «Rep. Argentina / Pr. Santiago d. Estero / 190_ / C. Bruch» print., the first one of this series of 7, in addition, «Lema / (Quasilema) / polichroma / Monrós [handwr.] / F. Monrós det. 1952 [print.]», all of these **ex BRC**. 1 of them pinned, «Salta» handwr. on green paper, **ex HB**. One of us (AOB) added to all «Lema / polichroma / Monrós 1952 / Syntypus» handwr. on red cardboard.

Note: Recorded by Monrós (1957: 186) as a synonym of *Lema (Quasilema) latipennis* Pic 1941 = *L. latebifasciata* Pic 1951.

polyspilota [*Chelymorpha*]. Burmeister 1870: 278. [Uruguay]: Montevideo, *leg.* Arachavaleta.

One **synt.**, originally pinned, and later glued to a card by Viana, «Banda / orient.» print. on dark green paper; «Col. / Antigua» print.; «*polyspilota* Nob. / Rep. orient.» handwr. by Burmeister. One of us (AOB) added «*Chelymorpha / polyspilota / Burmeister / Typus*» handwr. on red cardboard. **Ex HB**.

Notes: The spec. was filed by Viana in the drawer under *Anacassis cribrum* (Klug 1829) in the collection of MACN. Hincks (1950: 509) considered that *Chelymorpha* Chevrolat 1838 is a synonym of *Cyphomorpha* Hope [1840]. With «Banda Oriental» Uruguay is meant.

Note: Monrós (1959: 31) recorded it as a synonym of *Ernoporos splendida* (Philippi), transferred from *Oyarzuna*.

proxima [*Lema*]. Burmeister 1877: 54. Paraguay

Four **synt.**, pinned on 3 pins, 1st (with 2) and 3^d pins «Paraguay» print. on green paper, 2^d pin without labels. One of us (AOB) added to all «Lema / proxima / Burmeister 1877 / Syntypi [Syntypus]» handwr. on red cardboard. **Ex HB**.

Notes: Monrós (1947a: 169) put *paraguayensis* de Borre, and *paraguensis*: Clavareau in Schenking as synonyms of *proxima*. Monrós (1951: 476) included the species in *Lema (Quasilema)*, and put *L. maculipes* Pic as a synonym.

proxima [*Stenispia*]. Monrós & Viana 1947: 169-170, pl. ii: 9. Corrientes Prov.: Nueva Valencia in MACN; Entre Ríos Prov.: Paraná Bravo River in GKC. 14 **cotypes** in MACN, MC, AMC, MVC, GKC.

Two **synt.**, one of them «Corrientes / Nueva Valencia / M. Viana 1947» handwr.; «51112» handwr., red frame; the other one «Dibujado» [drawn] handwr.; «R. Bravo (Delta) / E. Ríos 6/2/43» handwr., black frame; «51111» handwr., red frame. Both «Cotypus» print. on red cardboard; «*Stenispia / proxima / Monrós - Viana / Cotipo* [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print.]» on red cardboard.

Notes: Gaedicke & Döbler (1971: 358) report two synt. from Entre Ríos Prov. in DEI. Under «R. Bravo» the Paraná Bravo Stream is meant. Staines & Staines (1997:18) mention that seven specimens from Monrós collection are in the USNM.

quadriplagiata [*Epitrix*]. Bryant 1951: 939-940, f. 2. [Buenos Aires Prov.]: Balcarce II.1948, 9 spec. *leg.* Hepper; La Rioja Prov.: Patquía XII.1932, 2 **spec.** on potato plants.

Two **synt.?, parat.?**, on cards, on 1 pin, «Paratype» on 2 disks with yellow border; «ex hojas de planta de papa» [from leaves of potato plants], «S. Miguel / BA. III.48 / H.C. Hepper», handwr. by Hepper; «Com. Inst. Ent. / Coll. no. 12021» print., number handwr.; «53428» handwr., red frame; «*Epitrix / quadriplagiata / Bryant* [handwr.] / G.E. Bryant det. [print.]» on white paper.

Notes: San Miguel was not mentioned in the original description, but otherwise the labels seem authentic. The spec. are retulated as paratypes, but they could be syntypes.

Note: Recorded as *Coraliomela quadrimaculata* var. *quinquenotata* by Fischer (1935: 286), and as *Coraliomela thoracica* ab. *quinquenotata* by Monrós & Viana (1947: 181-182, pl. X: 32).

rectecarinata [*Aulacochlamys*]. Monrós 1952b: 658-661, f. 172 a-c. Corrientes Prov.: Santo Tomé leg. Pellerano, 3 **parat.** in **MACN**. **Holot.**, Tucumán Prov.: San Javier 3.XII.1944 Golbach leg., in **FIML**, other **parat.** in **MC**.

Three **parat.** «S. Tomé / Corrientes / 2-925 [on one, the other two without date]» print., black frame, date handwr.; one of them in addition «Santo Tomé / Corrientes / G. Pellerano» handwr.; «53403» handwr., red frame; «Paratypus» print. on yellow cardboard with a black frame; «*Aulacochlamys* / rectecarinata / mihi [handwr.] / F. Monrós det. 1950 [print.]» on pink [white] paper.

reducta [*Uroplata*]. Monrós & Viana 1947: 297-298, pl. xxv: 106. Santa Fe Prov.: San Justo, leg. Daguerre, 1 **cot.** in **MACN**, 1 **cot.** in **JDC**.

One **synt.** «Dibujado» [drawn] handwr.; «Santa Fe / San Justo / 3.XI.942 / Daguerre» handwr. by Daguerre; «51155» handwr., red frame; «*Uroplata* / (Codiohispa) / reducta / Monrós-Viana / Cotipo [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print.] [obverse] / X-1947 [handwr.] [reverse]» on white paper with a black frame.

Note: Described from two syntypes, the other specimen is from the Daguerre collection, now in the USNM (Ward *et al.*, 1976; Staines & Staines 1997: 18).

ruficollis [*Psatyrocerus*]. Brèthes 1928: 206. Chile, leg. Porter.

Note: No reference to **BRC** was made in the original description, but otherwise the type condition seems authentic.

saucius [*Monachus*]. Burmeister 1877: 63-64. [Uruguay]: Montevideo and [Argentina]: Buenos Aires.

Two **synt.**, one of them «Buen. / Ayres» print. on green paper, the other «*saucius* / Nob.» handwr. by Burmeister. One of us (AOB) added to both «*Monachus* / saucius / Burmeister 1877 / Syntypus» handwr. on red cardboard. *Ex HB*.

Note: Recorded by Blackwelder (1946: 644) under *Lexiphanes* Gistel 1850 *nom. nov. pro Monachus* Déjean 1835 *et* Chevrolat 1837, *non* Fleming 1822 *nec* Kaup 1829.

seabrai [*Goniochenia* (*Baranosa*)]. Viana 1966: 115-119, f. 1, 2. Brasil: Benjamin Constant, **holot.** ♂, **allot.** ♀, **parat.**; Brasil: Acre, **parat.**, in **CSC**. Other **parat.** in **MF**, **DC**.

Five **parat.**, one of them «Brasil / Benj. Constant / Rio Javary / alto Amazonas 10.1942 / Dirings.» print., date handwr.; «Coll. Dirings. / S. Paulo. Brasil / 748» print.. Two of them «Puerto Walter / Acre. Bras. 56» print.; «Museum Frey / Tützing» print.. Two of them «Benjamin Constant / Am. Brasil. XI.1962. A. Silva col.» handwr. All «Paratypus» print. on yellow cardboard, black frame; «*Goniochenia* / (*Baranosa*) / seabrai / Viana / Paratipo [obverse] / M. Viana / X-1966 [reverse]», handwr.

Bruch» print., «Paratipo» handwr. on white paper, red frame, «I. empyrea / ssp. smaragdina / mihi [handwr.] / F. Monrós det. 1950 [print.]» on pink paper.

sordidulus [*Chlamisus*]. Monrós 1952b: 614-618, f. 94, 119, 146. subaenea [*Paria*]. Jacoby 1900: 510. La Plata, several **spec.** received from Mons. Clavareau, Brussels.

Three **synt.** on cards, on one pin, «Rep. Argentina / Prov. Buenos Aires / 190_ / C. Bruch» print.; «Cotypus» print. on pale green paper, «*Paria* / *subaenea* / Jac.» handwr. by Bruch, red frame; «*Paria* / *subaenea*» handwr., cut.

Note: Bechyné (1953: 121, 272) downgraded the species to an *aberratio* of *Periparia boggianii*, stating that they differ only by color, a quite variable feature.

Holot.? **synt.?**, «Dibujado» [drawn] handwr., «Corrientes / San Roque / II-920 - Bosq» handwr. by Bruch, «Col. / C. Bruch» print., «50916» handwr., red frame, «Typus» print. on red cardboard, «*Stenispa* / *sulcatifrons* / Pic» handwr. by Bruch, green frame, «*Stenispa* / *sulcatifrons* n.sp.» handwr., cut, there are some other illegible traits; «*Stenispa* / *sulcatifrons* / Pic / Det. M. Viana [handwr.] / Museo Argentino de Ciencias Naturales [print., obverse] / X-1947 [handwr.] [reverse]».

Notes: Pic did not mention how many spec. he examined, but the only repository recorded is **BRC**, where a single spec. is kept. Descarpentries & Villers (1959) state that there is no type in **PC**. Moreover, this spec. was labelled «Typus», not «Cotypus» by Bruch. So the holot. condition could be inferred. Monrós & Viana (1947: 166, 167, pl. ii: 10) examined the spec.
